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PROCEEDINGS

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CHAIRMAN: The final item on our agenda, regular agenda, this is Item 7, Detailed Site Plan DSP-04054-07, Bellefonte (Clinton Self Storage). This also is a request, actually my, let me take that back. I think my notes are off. Hold on one second. Yeah, okay, all right. So, we have Mr. Tedesco representing the Applicant. We have Hyo Jung Garland, who is going to give a Staff presentation; and help me out, David, because my note are actually confused on this one. This is, this is a matter, request for a continuance, right? THE CLERK: Right. This matter was continued from the 9th until this date. CHAIRMAN: Okay. All right. So, this is an evidentiary hearing. We do not have anyone signed up. did have somebody signed up, but they cancelled. So, we'll only swear people in if we have anyone who needs to be sworn-in; and we'll start with the Staff presentation. MS. GARLAND: So, this is Hyo Jung Garland. Should I start? CHAIRMAN: Yes, you can start. Introduce yourself for the record.

MS. GARLAND: All right.

CHAIRMAN: And the floor is yours.

MS. GARLAND: Absolutely. Thank you. Good

1 morning, Mr. Chair and members of the Board. For the 2 record, I am Hyo Jung Garland with Urban Design Section. 3 Item No. 7 is the Detailed Site Plan, DSP-04054 --4 CHAIRMAN: Ms. Garland, let me interrupt a second. 5 You don't need to be on camera, but you are, we cannot see 6 you. We can only hear you. You don't need to be. I just 7 wanted to make sure --8 MS. GARLAND: Yeah. Thank you for saying that 9 because I want to actually be on the camera, but somehow 10 it's not showing up. I thought it was blocked out, but if 11 it's not the case, I will just turn it off. 12 CHAIRMAN: Go ahead. 13 MS. GARLAND: All right. 14 CHAIRMAN: And you're fine, so, so, we can still 15 hear you; so, just keep going. 16 MS. GARLAND: Okay. So, I will just continue 17 that. Okay. So, this Item No. 7 is Detailed Site Plan, 18 DSP-04054-07, Bellefonte, which requests an amendment to 19 DSP-04054 to add approximately 19,000 square feet of 20 additional consolidated storage units to Lot 159. The 21 Applicant has also requested a variance of .06 to the FIR 22 requirement of the I-4 Zone of the prior Zoning Ordinance. 23 The Urban Design Section recommended that the 24 Planning Board adopted the finding of the report and then

approved the Detailed Site Plan, including the variance to

Section 27-472(d)(1) and Type 2 Tree Conservation Plan TCP2-1 2 114-04-05, subjected to the recommended condition of, of 3 approval within the Technical Staff Report. The Applicant has reviewed these conditions and would like to request one 5 clarification for the Staff analysis language. If you allow 6 me, I would like to bring the Applicant to the table. 7 CHAIRMAN: Thank you. Ms., Ms. Garland, let us, 8 just take us through the process. Once we're, once you've 9 completed your Staff presentation, I'll turn to the 10 Applicant and we can have opportunity to take this up when 11 they speak, okay? 12 MS. GARLAND: Sounds great. Thank you. 13 CHAIRMAN: Okay. Anything else from Staff? 14 MS. GARLAND: That's it. 15 CHAIRMAN: Okay. Thank you, Ms. Garland. Thank 16 you very much. We'll now turn to the Applicant, Mr. 17 Tedesco, and you can certainly pick up what Ms. Garland was 18 talking about. Could you introduce yourself for the record? 19 MR. TEDESCO: Yes, absolutely. Thank you again, 20 Mr. Chairman, members of the Planning Board. For the 21 record, Matthew Tedesco, law firm, McNamee Hosea in 22 Greenbelt on behalf of the Applicant Clinton Self Storage, 23 LLC, trading as Store Space Self Storage. 24 Just want to before I pick up where Ms. Garland

left off with respect to just one clarifying item in the

findings. I did want to just take one quick moment to remind the Board that as Mr. Water indicated, this case was continued from November 9th until today. Primarily the basis for that was both Mr. Garland taking over this case for Mr. Shelly, as well as myself taking over this case for my late partner, Mr. Lynch. So, I wanted to once, just again, thank you all for that accommodation. I want to thank Ms. Garland for her professional ability to step in and get this case back before you in a very quick turnaround, notwithstanding those items that came on, that landed on both of our laps; and so, Ms. Garland has done a fantastic job getting this case before you and I want to publicly thank her for that in presenting it here to you all this morning.

This case is very straightforward. The existed consolidated storage facility is constructed. We are proposing two additional buildings being F and G, which are basically in the middle of the hole in the donut, so to speak, of the existing buildings that are on the subject property. All the requisite findings as it relates to this application have been well-articulated in your Staff Report, as well as the conditions. We are in agreement with all conditions.

That leads me to Ms. Garland's team meet-up for just one quick minor modification that can be made in your

resolution for this item and it relates to Finding No. 10, which is on page 26 of your Staff Report as it relates to Conditions 12 and 13 of the Preliminary Plan of Subdivision that was approved. So, if I can direct your attention to page 26 of Finding 10 in response to Conditions 12 and 13, which have to do with the acoustical analysis conditions of the Preliminary Plan, those conditions are relative to buildings and construction, accepting those buildings that are used to for storage purposes. So, you can see in Conditions 12 and 13 it says unless structures or portions thereof are designed only for storage purposes, then the acoustical analysis is not needed.

In Staff's finding on page 26, it says at the time of building permits and acoustical analysis, must be provided for the two structures. That's, we've since talked with Staff. That's technically not correct and Staff has acknowledged that needed tweak there given the condition exempts buildings that are used solely for storage, which these two buildings will be used solely for storage as complimentary to the existing storage facility on the property.

So, with that, Mr. Chairman, I appreciate your indulgence to get me clarify that. We have no other further requested modifications to any conditions and, again, thank Ms. Garland. Look forward to working with her on many other

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    projects in the future and appreciate the Staff's time and
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    consideration of this Application. We'd respectfully

TEDESCO: Yeah, I'm, I'm asking for that 20 finding to be revised to indicate that an acoustical 21 analysis is not required since these buildings are for 22 storage purposes only and that Conditions 12 and 13 of the
