said land first ha	ving obtained a grading permit from the Director. No grading permit may be			
issued by the Dir	ector unless approvals have been obtained from the Department of			
Environmental R	esources, the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission, the Department of			
Public Works and	d Transportation, the State Highway Administration or the Health Department			
or permits for inf	Frastructure improvements including streets, utilities, or stormwater management

1	facilities have been issued for the property. The requirement for an infrastructure permit shall					
2	not apply to property for which a grading permit is necessary in an emergency situation to					
3	prevent injury to persons or property, or to property on which a regulated public utility company					
4	or a contractor authorized by a public agency is performing utility work including installation of					
5	transmission or water and sewer lines, roads or stormwater management facilities. An					
6	infrastructure permit shall not be required for a grading permit applied for in conjunction with					
7	any building permit, or a single-family dwelling on a private lot constructed for or by the owner					
8	a sanitary landfill pursuant to an approved Special Exception site plan, grading necessary for					
9	reforestation, resurfacing or expansion of an existing parking lot, the construction of sidewalks,					
10	driveways, trails, recreation facilities, individual well and septic systems, or the placement of					
11	signs.
