requirements of this Section a	<u>re met.</u>
(b) The conservation la	nd must be used:

2	(2) for the environmental education of the public;	
3	(3) generally to promote conservation; or	
4	(4) for the maintenance of:

6	(ii) a sanctuary for wildlife.	
7	(c) Application and proof of eligibility for exemption shall be filed with the Office of Law	
8	no later than October 1 of the tax year for which exemption is sought.
