5	(I) Any subdivision of land to be used primarily for the purpose of developing a						
6	qualified data center is subject to the following additional requirements:						
7	(i) Notwithstanding Section 24-3303(b)(2) of these Regulations, an						
8	applicant for a final plat for the subdivision of land proposed to be used primarily for a qualified						
9	data center is required to conduct a pre-application neighborhood meeting in accordance with						
10	Section 24-3303, Pre-Application Neighborhood Meeting, and						
11	(ii) Notwithstanding Section 24-4503(a), a certificate of adequacy has been						
12	issued in accordance with Section 24-4500, Public Facility Adequacy.

14	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby						
15	declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,						
16	sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of						
17	competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining						
18	words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this						
19	Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such						
20	invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,						
21	or section.						
22	SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect thirty (30)						
23	calendar days after it becomes law.
