RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 FY 2017-2026 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan

3 For the purpose of adopting the Prince George’s County FY 2017-2026 Ten Year Solid Waste
4 Management Plan as recommended by the County Executive.

5 WHEREAS, Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of
6 Maryland requires the County to adopt and submit to the Maryland Department of the
7 Environment a comprehensive plan dealing with solid waste disposal systems, and solid waste
8 acceptance facilities; and

9 WHEREAS, Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of
10 Maryland provides procedures governing the preparation and adoption of the plan, and provides
11 for amendments and revisions thereto; and

12 WHEREAS, pursuant to said procedures, the County Executive submitted to the County
13 Council a proposed FY 2017-2026 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan (the
14 “Plan) to update the FY 2012-2022 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, the County Council received testimony through an advertised public hearing;
17 and

18 WHEREAS, the County Council notified the municipalities, the Washington Suburban
19 Sanitary Commission, the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, and the
20 Maryland Department of the Environment of the public hearings and provided each agency with
21 copies of the proposed Plan.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George’s

1 County, Maryland, that the document titled "Draft" and attached hereto is hereby adopted as the
2 Prince George's County FY 2017-2026 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management
3 Plan, as amended.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the adopted Prince George's County FY 2012-2022
5 Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan is repealed and superseded.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within five (5) working days of the adoption of this
7 resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive by the Clerk of the Council.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
9 Maryland, that this resolution shall take effect on the day following the first regularly scheduled
10 Council meeting day which occurs after the County Executive transmits his comments on this
11 resolution, or on the day that the County Executive indicates he has no comments, or ten (10)
12 working days following transmittal of this resolution to the County Executive, whichever shall
13 occur first. Prior to the effective date of this resolution, the Council may reconsider its action
14 based upon any recommendation received from the County Executive.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the effective date of this resolution, it shall be
16 transmitted by the Clerk of the Council to the Secretary of the Maryland Department of the
17 Environment.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of the Environment shall provide an
19 informational briefing to the County Council by May 1, 2018 detailing results of the Study and
20 Analysis of Waste Management Alternatives for Prince George's County.
