BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

This Resolution will expand the existing Woodview Village District created by CR-37-1996; designate such existing Woodview Village District as a separate subdistrict within the expanded district; re-name such existing Woodview Village District; designate and create the expansion area property as a separate subdistrict within the expanded district; name such expansion area subdistrict; make certain findings, determinations and declarations in connection with such expansion, designation, creation, naming and re-naming; provide that each subdistrict within the expanded district shall be deemed to be a separate special taxing district for purposes of Section 10-269 of the Prince George's County Code; authorize the approval, execution and delivery of certain development agreements; and generally relating to the development of and the financing, refinancing and reimbursement of costs related to certain infrastructure improvements within or outside such subdistricts.
