For the purpose of am	ending the Prince George's County Ten Year Solid Waste Management
Plan by adding the Sun Services, LLC Recycling Facility located at Somerset Avenue and Old	
Baltimore Pike, Beltsv	ville.
WHEREAS, Titl	e 9, subtitle 5 of the Environmental Article of the Annotated Code of
Maryland ("Code") requires that each county adopt and submit to the Maryland Department of	
the Environment ("MDE") a county Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan ("Plan") dealing	
with solid waste disposal systems and solid waste acceptance facilities and to submit	
amendments and revis	ions thereto; and
WHEREAS, Sec	tion 9-515 of the Code establishes procedures governing the preparation,
adoption and amendments of the Plan in Prince George's County; and	
WHEREAS, the	Prince George's County FY 2002 – 2011 Plan was adopted by the County
Council in Council Re	solution 44-2002; and
WHEREAS, the	County Council wishes to amend and revise the references in the Plan to
"Acceptance Facilities	" which are currently operating in the County; and
WHEREAS, Sun	Services, LLC, the user of the property located at Somerset Avenue and
Old Baltimore Pike in	Beltsville, is proposing a recycling facility; and
WHEREAS, the	properties located at Lots 9 through 30, Block 56, Section 3 in the
Beltsville Subdivision	are zoned I-2; and
WHEREAS, a re	cycling facility is a permitted use on property zoned I-2; and
WHEREAS, the	County Council, pursuant to Section 9-515 of the Code, notified the

Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC), the Maryland-National Capital Park and
Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) and the surrounding property owners of the public hearing
and provided each with copies of the proposed amendment thirty (30) days prior to the public
hearing: and

WHEREAS, the County Council received comments through the advertised public hearing and from the agencies.

SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County FY 2002 – 2011 Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan as adopted CR-44-2002 is amended as follows:

- a. Amend Chapter III, Section III. Entitled "Acceptance Facilities" to read as follows:

J. Sun Services, LLC Recycling Facility

The Sun Services, LLC Recycling Facility is a privately owned facility being developed on 13 14 the 4.3024 acre site located at Somerset Avenue and Old Baltimore Pike in Beltsville (see Figure 15 3.13). A 20,000 square foot building will be constructed on the site and shall meet Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certification requirements. Truck traffic to and from 16 the facility shall be routed through Powder Mill Road during hours of operation. The facility 17 18 shall only accept source separated materials from construction or demolition of structures, 19 including wood, metal, cardboard, shingles, masonry, and drywall. All incoming debris will be 20 weighted, inspected to insure that only acceptable materials are delivered and deposited inside of the wholly enclosed building for sorting. Recyclable materials will be separated and shipped off-21 22 site for reuse. Up to 85% of the materials are expected to be recycled. A dust suppression 23 system shall be utilized inside the 20,000 s.f. building. The proposed site impacts to Indian 24 Creek shall be reduced as the site will be paved, sufficient streams buffers created and 25 stormwater management techniques shall be utilized. The site will include stormwater 26 management water quality controls for 100% of the site impervious area. Stormwater 27 management techniques will include porous pavement within the parking stall areas and 28 landscaped bio-retention swales within the buffer areas. Sun Services, LLC Recycling Facility, 29 in addition to any County requirements, shall coordinate landscaping with local watershed 30 protection groups, including the Anacostia Watershed Society. The facility shall not accept municipal solid waste, putrescible wastes (other than wood), mattresses, tires (unless licensed by 31

1	the State as a tire recycling facility), liquids, paint, paint thinner, tar creosote, adhesives, animal
2	carcasses, septiage, biosolids, yard waste, controlled hazardous substances, compressed gas
3	cylinder, drums or tanks that have held hazardous materials, shock sensitive materials or
4	explosives.

13	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within five (5) working days of the
14	adoption of the resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive by the Clerk of the
15	Council.
16	SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect on the
17	day following the first regularly scheduled Council meeting day which occurs after the County
18	Executive transmits his comments on this amendment, or ten (10) working days following the
19	transmittal of this resolution to the County Executive, whichever shall occur first. Prior to the
20	effective date of this resolution, the County may reconsider its action based upon any
21	recommendation received from the County Executive.
22	SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the effective date of this
23	resolution it shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the Council to the Secretary of the Maryland
24	Department of the Environment.
