PUBLIC SAFETY AND FISCAL MANAGEMENT

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Knotts, Campos, Dean, Exum and Harrington).

This bill will amend the classification plan of the collective bargaining agreement by abolishing job classification in Salary Schedule V.

The Service Employees International Union (SEIU) local 400PG was decertified as the representative of the employees in the Office of the States Attorney as of March 6, 2007 by the Public Employees Relations Board (PERB) Case No. R-07-2006. The positions are administrative aide I, II, III and clerk typist I, II.

The bill was amended on page 2 line 8 by deleting July 1, 2007 and adding March 6, 2007.

There will not be any negative fiscal impact on the county as a result of enacting CB-41-2007.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This Bill amends the Classification Plan by abolishing the job classifications formerly represented by SEIU Local 400PG, which was decertified as representative of this unit of employees effective March 6, 2007 in Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board in Case No. R-07-2006.
