#### **AGENDA**

1. <u>CB-03-2012 Proposed DR-2A</u> (Harrison and Davis) —An Ordinance concerning Interim Land Use Controls for Military Installation Conformance for the purpose of developing new development standards and procedures, including the establishment and imposition of temporary zoning requirements for development of properties in the vicinity of Joint Base Andrews for an established limited period of time. This Ordinance creates requirements for granting permits for development, provides for definitions, and establishes a limited validity period for building permits, creating interim requirements for development in all zones.

**Favorable with amendments 5-0** (In favor: Council Members Franklin, Patterson, Olson, Harrison and Toles.)

2. <u>CB-04-2012 Proposed DR-2A</u> (Harrison and Davis) - A Subdivision Bill concerning Interim Land Use Controls for Military Installation Conformance for the purpose of developing new development standards and procedures, including the establishment and imposition of temporary subdivision requirements for development of properties in the vicinity of Joint Base Andrews for an established limited period of time. This Ordinance amends the Subdivision Regulations to permit the Planning Board to attach conditions to preliminary plans and final plats filed in the ILUC Area and establishes restrictions on preliminary plans in portions of the ILUC Area.

**Favorable with amendments 5-0** (In favor: Council Members Franklin, Patterson, Olson, Harrison and Toles.)

3. <u>CR-63-2012</u> (Olson) - A Resolution concerning the Enactment of a Certain Ordinance of the Town of Riverdale Park for the purpose of approving the enactment of Ordinance 2012-OR-08, concerning residential storage.

Favorable 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Franklin, Patterson, Olson and Toles.)

**4.** <u>CR-64-2012</u> (Campos) - A Resolution concerning The Approved 2004 Prince George's Gateway Arts District Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) and Development District Overlay Zone for the purpose of authorizing the Planning Board to prepare an amendment to the Approved 2004 Gateway Arts District Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) and Development District Overlay Zone revising certain development district standards within the Gateway Arts District.

Favorable with amendments 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Franklin, Patterson, Olson and Toles.)

**5.** <u>CB-73-2012</u> (County Executive) -An Act amending provisions of the Code concerning the regulations for Farmers Markets.

**6.** <u>CB-76-2012</u> (Harrison) - An Ordinance concerning the Industrial Zones – Transfer Stations for the purpose of providing for a transfer station as a permitted use under certain circumstances.
