**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Issuance and Sale of General Obligation Bonds

3 For the purpose of repealing certain remaining unused authorizations to issue and sell serial  
 4 maturity bonds, including bonds with mandatory sinking fund installments in lieu of serial  
 5 maturities.

6 BY repealing the following Acts of the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, to  
 7 the extent of the authority granted but unused as of the effective date of this Act and as specified  
 8 in Attachment 1, attached to and made a part of this Act:

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
10 Maryland, that certain acts of the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland,  
11 specified in the table set forth in Attachment 1, attached hereto and made a part of this Act, be  
12 and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of the authority granted but unused as of the date  
13 on which this Act becomes effective, with the dollar amounts of such unused authority being  
14 listed in Attachment 1 hereof.

15 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that through the enactment hereof the County  
16 Council in no way intends to repeal or amend any authority previously given by the County  
17 Council pursuant to which Prince George's County, Maryland, has, prior to the date or effective  
18 date hereof, issued bonds.

19 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby  
20 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,  
21 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of  
22 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining  
23 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this  
24 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such  
25 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, subparagraph, paragraph, subsection,  
26 or section.

27 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)  
28 calendar days after it becomes law.
