SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that certain acts of the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, specified in the table set forth in Attachment 1, attached hereto and made a part of this Act, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of the authority granted but unused as of the date on which this Act becomes effective, with the dollar amounts of such unused authority being listed in Attachment 1 hereof.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that through the enactment hereof the County Council in no way intends to repeal or amend any authority previously given by the County Council pursuant to which Prince George's County, Maryland, has, prior to the date or effective date hereof, issued bonds.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, subparagraph, paragraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
