## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

The enactment of certain Ordinances of the City of Bowie FOR the purpose of approving Ordinances 0-01-90 and 0-02-90.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Bowie, after a public hearing, reenacted Chapter 26 and amended Sections 26-1 and 26-11 through 26-13 of the Code of the City of Bowie on February 5, 1990; and

WHEREAS, these Ordinances (attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachments A and B, and hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinances") enact definitions and other regulations pertaining to fences, residential parking and residential storage within the boundaries of the City of Bowie; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland Annotated Code authorizes municipalities within the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District to enact ordinances affecting fences, residential parking and residential storage for the purpose of preserving, improving and protecting the general character and design of lands within the corporate limits of the municipality, provided that such ordinances impose stricter or additional limitations or restrictions than are otherwise imposed by County zoning regulations; and

WHEREAS, Article 28 Section 8-112.1 of the Maryland Annotated Code provides that such ordinances shall not be effective until approved by the County Council for Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowie, pursuant to Article 28, Section 8-112.1 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, has delivered a certified copy of the Ordinances to the District Council; and

WHEREAS, the County Council, sitting as the District Council, has determined that Ordinance 0-01-90 and 0-02-90 impose restrictions on the storage or parking of vehicles in residential areas, parking of inoperative vehicles, parking on unpaved areas, construction of detached garages and sheds, and construction of fences that are in addition to those currently imposed by Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council for Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council, for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Ordinance 0-01-90 and 0-02-90 of the City of
