## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

Task Force on High School Capacity Alternatives

For the purpose of establishing a Task Force on High School Capacity Alternatives to analyze alternatives to provide additional pupil capacity at high school facilities in the County.

WHEREAS, Prince George's County is anticipating a dramatic increase in the number of students attending high school that will exceed the existing capacity of County high schools; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education for Prince George's County is responsible for providing an educational program for all students of high school age who reside in the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Government, in conjunction with the State of Maryland, is responsible for providing funding for the construction and operation of public school facilities in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education for Prince George's County has presented a proposed capital construction program for high schools that is based on the construction of significant additions to 5 existing high schools in the northern portion of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Council, for two consecutive budget years, has expressed a preference for the construction of an additional new high school in lieu of the proposed addition program to address the shortage of classroom space in high schools in the northern portion of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has deferred the appropriation of funds to construct the proposed high school additions until an evaluation of alternatives to constructing additions has been thoroughly and thoughtfully considered by all responsible parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that The Task Force on High School Capacity Alternatives is created and charged with the responsibility to:

- 1. Analyze the Board of Education's proposal to construct additions to five of the County's existing high schools;
- 2. Analyze alternative proposals to construct an additional high school in the northern portion of the County and other alternative measures to address issues relating to high school capacity;
- 3. Evaluate potential sites for the construction of an additional high school in the northern portion of the County;
  - 4. Evaluate alternative funding strategies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force on High School Capacity Alternatives shall have a total of 13 members comprised of:

- 1. 3 members appointed by the County Executive;
- 2. 3 members appointed by the Board of Education for Prince George's County;
- 3. 3 members appointed by the County Council, one of whom shall be designated as the Chairman;
- 4. 1 member appointed by the Chair of the Prince George's County Senate Delegation;
- 5. 1 member appointed by the Chair of the Prince George's County House Delegation;
- 6. 1 member appointed by the State Board of Education; and
- 7. 1 member appointed by the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force on High School Capacity Alternatives shall present its recommendations to the County Executive, the County Council, and the Board of Education no later than September 28, 2004.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator shall provide appropriate staff support to the Task Force on High School Capacity Alternatives.
