Dear Chairman Shapiro:

On October 10, 2022, the Council received your letter requesting an eight-week extension of the period to prepare the Preliminary Master Plan of Transportation pursuant to Section 27-3502(d)(5) of the Zoning Ordinance. As set forth therein, we are aware that the Clerk of the Council has identified a scheduling conflict with the Joint Public Hearing for the Master Plan of Transportation 2035 schedule and the Fiscal Year 2024 budget season schedule and work sessions. To this end, and in order to support the County Council's work programs and schedule, the Council has considered and hereby grants the eight-week extension to the previously estimated time to prepare the Preliminary Master Plan of Transportation 2035 document.

As a result of the approval of this extension, it is our further understanding that the Planning Board should now grant permission to print and release the Preliminary Master Plan of Transportation 2035 and transmit the Public Facilities Referral to the County Executive beginning on or about March 23, 2023, and that this extension slightly impacts the final approval of the master plan by one month, which is now scheduled for December 2023.
