WHEREAS	S, during the Fiscal Year 1994 Bi-County budget process the Montgomery and	
Prince George's	County Councils established a Bi-County Working Group to recommend	
changes that wou	ald control the growth of debt and maintain future rate increases at WSSC close	
to the level of in	flation; and	
WHEREAS, the Working Group's January 1994 Report recommended the establishment of		
a spending afford	dability process; and	
WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council endorsed the entire Working Group's		
report through the adoption of CR-12-1994 and the Montgomery Council endorsed part		
of the report's red	commendations through Resolution #12-1558; and	
WHEREAS	S, the Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group	
Report spending	affordability process; and	
WHEREAS	S, both Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process	
beginning with the	he formulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and	
WHEREAS, the Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the		
Montgomery and	d Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make	
certain recommendations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2008 Operating and Capital Budgets; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery Council have reviewed the information compiled by the staff relating to spending control limits on the percentage of water and sewer increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures;

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council recommends that WSSC, in conjunction with its Fiscal Year 2008 Budget transmittal, identify priority items that would not be funded within the approved Fiscal Year 2008 spending control limits. These items can be considered for funding at the May 2007 Bi-County meeting; and

WHEREAS, revenue from surplus property sales increases WSSC fund balance which can be used to address one-time budgetary needs and/or provide one-time rate relief;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council hereby endorses the following spending control limits for the Fiscal Year 2008 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission:

Water and Sewer Bill increase: five point three percent (5.3%) New Water and Sewer Debt: One hundred and sixty-one million, four hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$161,450,000) Water and Sewer Debt Service: One hundred and sixty million, nine hundred and twenty-two thousand dollars (\$160,922,000) Water and Sewer Operating Four hundred and fifty-four million, Fund Expenditures: thirty-eight thousand dollars (\$454,038,000)
