WHEREAS	s, Section 29-120.01 of the Prince George's County Code provides a process for
the owner(s) of a	n historic property to petition for designation as an historic site with the Prince
George's County	Historic Preservation Commission; and
WHEREAS	, the Kleiner-Davidson White House, located at 8529 58 <sup>th</sup> Avenue, Berwyn
Heights, MD 207	740, is one of a small number of houses from the 1920s in the late Victorian
suburb of Charlto	on Heights (Berwyn Heights); and
WHEREAS	, this property is an excellent example of the use of early 20 <sup>th</sup> century mail-
order houses pro	duced by Sears, Roebuck & Company and embodies the distinctive
characteristics of	the Craftsman style of domestic architecture of the 1920s and 1930s; and
WHEREAS	, in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 29-120.01, Ann Harris Davidson
filed a petition w	ith the Historic Preservation Commission for designation of her property as a
Historic Site on I	March 15, 2009; and
WHEREAS	, Ms. Davidson, the author the book Berwyn Heights: Then and Now, provided
substantial docur	mentation on the history and significance of the house as part of the application
process; and	

WHEREAS, after proper posting and notice was given as required by law, the Prince

George's County Historic Preservation Commission held a public hearing on May 19, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission determined that the Kleiner-Davidson White House and its Environmental Setting of 6,532 square feet (Lot 44, Block 20, Charlton Heights Subdivision) qualifies for Historic Site designation; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the District Council, held a joint public hearing on the significance of the property with the Prince George's County Planning Board on July 14, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the record of the hearing was left open until 5:00 p.m. on July 15, 2009; and WHEREAS, on July 16, 2009, the Prince George's County Planning Board voted unanimously to recommend that the Kleiner-Davidson White House be designated as an Historic Site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Kleiner-Davidson White House, 8529 58<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Berwyn Heights, MD 20740, is hereby designated as a Prince George's County Historic Site (67-022-24).
