BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The County's Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan was adopted on October 29, 2002, by CR-44-2002. A proposal to include a solid waste transfer station was rejected at that time. The proposed resolution will establish an advisory Environmental Justice Task Force to review criteria in the Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan and make recommendations for amendments that will mitigate the impact of proposed solid waste management facilities on minority and low-income communities.
