PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Date: 7/2/03

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 4-0, (In favor: Councilmembers Exum, Bland, Hendershot and Peters).

This resolution will amend the Salary Plan for Salary Schedule G – General Schedule Employees and provide G- Schedule Employees with a cost-of-living increase of 1.5% for FY2004.

The legislation was amended as follows:

1. On page 13, Section I, Military Leave, delete "two (2) calendar years from the date of adoption"

The Office of Law has reviewed the legislation and find it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

There will be a negative fiscal impact on the County of approximately \$1.2 million as a result of adopting CR-35-2003 related to the cost-of-living increase of 1.5% for FY2004.
