




PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP STRUCTURE




PURPLE LINE ALIGNMENT

PROJECT ACCOMPLISHMENTS




- 35% of track complete.
- Several miles of sidewalk complete.
- 20 of 21 stations are under construction.
- 12 station canopies installed.
- Project is more than 74% complete.
- Opened Talbot Avenue Bridge in May 2024.



LIGHT RAIL VEHICLES



- 8 of 28 light rail vehicles have been delivered to the Operations and Maintenance Facility; delivery will continue throughout 2025.
- 432-person total capacity with 80 seats available.
- Flex space and folding seats allow placement of 8 wheelchairs and 8 bicycles.
- Low floor with wide doorways for easy boarding.

UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD



Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Piney Branch Road and Riggs Road station platform and canopy are complete.
- Track installation progressing on University Boulevard (38% complete).
- Canopy artwork component has been installed.
- New sidewalks and curbs 99% completed.

- Continue track installation along University Boulevard, including Riggs Road and New Hampshire Avenue intersections.
- Install the windscreen artwork element.
- Begin Overhead Catenary System installation.



TAKOMA-LANGLEY STATION



Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Maintenance of Traffic shifted to establish work zone in the center of the University Boulevard from Piney Branch Road to New Hampshire Avenue.
- Demolition of existing road surface is underway.
- Station Art-in-Transit elements in production.
- Complete the excavation for station foundations.


- Start station platform foundations March 2025.
- Complete station structure by end of 2025.



TAKOMA-LANGLEY STATION ACCESS



- Station will offer easy connections to the Takoma Langley Crossroads Transit Center.
- Station will give riders access to businesses at each corner of the New Hampshire Avenue and University Boulevard intersection.
- Area will feature upgraded pedestrian infrastructure including crosswalks and signals.




NEW HAMPSHIRE AVENUE (MD 650) & UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD(MD 193)



March 28 - April 27, 2025

- Right turn only from New Hampshire Avenue onto University Boulevard and from University onto New Hampshire Avenue.
- Pedestrian crosswalks will be maintained.



NEW HAMPSHIRE AVENUE (MD 650) & UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD(MD 193) - DETOURS


 Detour routes include advanced detour options to shift traffic away from the intersection and local roads.

Southbound Riggs Road & Westbound University Boulevard Left Turn Detour Route.




Advanced Southbound Riggs Road Detour Route.



Northbound Riggs Road & Eastbound University Boulevard Left Turn Detour Route.





RIGGS ROAD (MD 212) & UNIVERSITY BLVD (MD 193)

February 27 – March 27, 2025

- Right turn only from Riggs
 Road onto University
 Boulevard and from University
 onto Riggs Road.
- Pedestrian crosswalks will be maintained.



CAMPUS DRIVE AND ADELPHI ROAD



Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Purple Line tracks have been installed across Adelphi Road.
- Lane closures have been removed and left turns onto Campus Drive have been restored.
- Curbs and sidewalks have been installed.
- Utility systems have been installed.

- Final paving.
- Complete signal adjustments.
- Overhead Catenary System (OCS) installation.



ADELPHI ROAD-UMGC-UMD STATION



Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Station platform completed.
- Station canopy installed.
- Preparations for track installation.

- Complete track installation.
- Continue station systems installation.
- Install Art-In-Transit station elements.







Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Complete stormwater drainage.
- Prepare site for track installation.
- Installed 12 planter boxes.
- 30% curb and sidewalk completed.

- Complete track installation.
- Install utilities.

UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND

Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Completed track installation from Presidential Drive to Rossborough Lane.
- Competed sidewalks and bicycle trails through campus.
- Installed 100% of OCS poles in the center of UMD campus.
- Installed 80% of light poles.

- Complete track installation on Presidential Drive.
- Install OCS wires and systems.
- Complete sidewalks.
- Complete tracks to Baltimore Avenue (Rt 1).
- Complete bike path on UMD Campus.










On or about March 1

- Install tracks and final utilities across Baltimore Avenue.
- Placement of track will be done in two parts starting with the western half of the road.
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction and shifted first to the east half then to the west of the road.
- Track work to be completed by beginning of Summer.



CAMPUS DRIVE FROM ROSSBOROUGH TO RIVER ROAD



Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Drainage systems completed.
- Multiple utility crossings and connections.
- Installed duct banks.
- Completed curb and sidewalks.
- Installed both sets of tracks.

- Shift traffic to north side of Campus Drive.
- Complete road reconstruction.



COLLEGE PARK METRO - CAMPUS DRIVE



Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Complete track installation from underpass to Metro station area.
- Complete utility installation.
- Completed track installation along Metro station.

Upcoming Work:

 Finish track installation where the temporary garage access was located.




COLLEGE PARK – UMD STATION

- Continue track placement.




RIVER ROAD

- Installed curved tracks from River Road to Kenilworth.
- Installed stormwater drainage.
- Installed curb, sidewalks and driveway connections (90% complete).
- Completed track placement at Rittenhouse Street.

KENILWORTH AVENUE TO RIVERDALE PARK KENILWORTH STATION



Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Completed ramp construction.
- Completed concrete for flyover.
- Installed canopy, windscreens and fencing for the station.
- Started track installation.
- Started the elevator and stair access to the station.

- Continue track installation.
- Complete the elevator and stair access to the station.
- Complete station utilities.



RIVERDALE ROAD



Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Completed track installation through Baltimore-Washington Parkway underpass.

- 90% completed architectural stonework at Baltimore-Washington Parkway bridges.
- Completed track across 66th Avenue.

- Continue sidewalks and curbs.




TRAIN TESTING



Test Track Location

- Adjacent to the Glenridge Operations and Maintenance Facility.
- 1 mile Parallel to Veterans Parkway (MD 410) between Annapolis Road & Riverdale Road.
- Test Track will be utilized for dynamic running tests of the trains.

Test of Train Systems


- Braking and Propulsion.
- Vehicle Safety Systems automatic vehicle locator, emergency communications.

Training

- Operator training.
- First Responder Training MTA Police and Prince George's County Police and Fire Departments.

Site Safety

- Dedicated alignment no access for public.
- No road crossings or interaction with motorists.
- State-of-the-art vehicle overrun protection.



TRAIN TESTING



Current Status

Trains

- 8 trains delivered and static tested.
- Remaining 20 planned to be delivered and static tested this year.

Trackwork

- Tracks built and tamped.
- Inspection and testing in progress.

Traction Power

- Substation installed and tested.
- Power cable installation in progress.

Overhead Catenary System

- Poles, brackets, tension wire complete.
- Contact wires, sectionalizing switches complete.
- Testing in progress.




PURPLE LINE TRANSIT OPERATORS



Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Completed training for Train Operators and Rail Director to support Dynamic Testing.
- Finalized train maintenance modules for PLTO team.
- Moved PLTO HQ to the Operations & Maintenance Facility (OMF) in Glenridge.

- Hiring direct line operating and maintenance staff as the project progresses.
- Continuing training to certify PLTO operating and maintenance team.
- Supporting the Dynamic Testing.



2025 ANTICIPATED MILESTONES



- Start of Train Dynamic Testing.
- Delivery of all 28 trains.
- First of the 21 station structures completed, with all under construction.
- Art-in-Transit installations underway.




ELECTED OFFICIAL ALERTS

SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS PROGRAM







Small Business Grant Program

The Purple Line Small Business Grant Program is operated by the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) to provide support to small businesses located along the Purple Line corridor that are impacted by construction.

Ø Benefits

Direct grants up to \$50,000, payable to eligible small businesses, are intended to offset the impact that construction closures or detours may have on business operations and may be used to pay any business expenses.



To be eligible for a grant, businesses must be in good standing with the Maryland State Department of Assessment and Taxation, federal and State taxing and licensing authorities, and in operation within one-quarter mile of the existing or future Purple Line alignment prior to January 1, 2022.
