## **DESIGNATION OF MONDAY, JUNE 16, 2003 AS LEGISLATIVE**

<u>DAY NO. 21</u> – Chairman Shapiro designated Monday, June 16, 2003 as Legislative Day number twenty-one.

## 1. SECOND READING OF BILLS (INTRODUCTION)

<u>CB-39-2003 –AN ACT CONCERNING A SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION</u> for the purpose of appropriating to the General Fund revenue in excess of budget estimates, to provide funds for costs that were not anticipated in the approved FY 2001-2002 budget for the Board of Education. - <u>INTRODUCED</u>

Council Bill 39, as proposed by Chairman Shapiro at the request of the County Executive, increases appropriations to the Board of Education by \$12,024,184, an amount supported by increased revenues of the same amount from unanticipated grant funding. Council Bill 39 was introduced by Chairman Shapiro and Vice-Chairman Knotts and referred to the Health, Education and Human Services Committee.
