### BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation includes several interdepartmental reallocations to assist in the fiscal year end closing process. Based on year-end savings in the Office of Law, Office of Human Resources Management, and

the Office of Homeland Security, \$2.0 million is requested to be reallocated collectively from those agencies to the Police Department to offset overages due to police retirement fringe expenses. Additionally, due to savings within the Department of Corrections, \$5.8 million is requested to be reallocated to the Fire/EMS Department to offset overages in fire retirement fringe expenses. Under this legislation, the total appropriation for the General Fund in FY 2024 does not change and remains at \$4,560,591,900 as expressed in CB-063-2023 and amended by CB-037-2024.
