RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Youth Commission

3 For the purpose of suspending certain provisions of the County Code relating to the Prince
4 George's County Youth Commission.

5 WHEREAS, the County Council enacted CB-19-2006 pertaining to the Youth Commission
6 on June 20, 2006, the County Executive signed the Act into law on June 29, 2006, as Chapter 12,
7 2006 Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland, and this Act took effect on August 14, 2006;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, Chapter 12 establishes the Prince George's County Youth Commission, sets
10 forth its duties and responsibilities, articulates the mission of the body, and provides
11 administrative authority to carry out these functions; and

12 WHEREAS, Section 2-497 of the County Code sets forth the composition, term, and
13 officers of the Commission; and

14 WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the provisions of Sections 2-497 in order to permit
15 the body to complete its work; and

16 WHEREAS, the repeal and reenactment of Section 2-497 of the County Code by legislative
17 act pursuant to the procedural requirements of Articles III and IV of the Charter cannot be
18 completed in a timely manner; and

19 WHEREAS, the public interest of the citizens and residents of the County is best served by
20 the expedient involvement of the County's youth in the affairs of County government and as a
21 vehicle for expression to articulate the needs of youth and the teen population in the County; and

1 WHEREAS, Section 1017(c) of the Charter for Prince George's County provides that a
2 resolution adopted by the Council shall have the force and effect of law but of a temporary or
3 administrative character; and

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
5 County, Maryland, that the provisions of Section 2-497 are hereby temporarily suspended until
6 March 15, 2009.
