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**REPORT:** Favorable 9-0: Council Members Hawkins, Davis, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Streeter, Taveras, and Turner. Absent: Franklin.

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on February 10, 2022, to consider CR-007-2022. CR-007-2022 is a Resolution to approve a multi-year contract with Stryker Medical to purchase Advanced Life Support (ALS)/Basic Life Support (BLS) equipment for the Fire/EMS Department. Pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland, the County Council must approve by resolution all multi-year contracts exceeding an aggregate of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00). The contract will approve a contract with Stryker Medical to provide zero percent interest on the purchase of ALS/BLS equipment in the amount of \$4,142,381.85.

This agreement is for five years, and Fire/EMS Department will make yearly payments of \$828,476.37 until payment is made in full.

The Office of Law finds CR-007-2022 to be in proper legislative form with no impediments to its adoption.

The Policy Group reports that the adoption of CR-007-2022 will have a negative impact on the County in the amount of \$ 4,142,381.85.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, favorably reported CR-007-2022 out 9-0.
