WHEREAS	s, the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is the owner of	
certain real prope	erty containing 75.31 acres of land acquired by deed from the State Roads	
Commission of M	Maryland, acting on behalf of the State of Maryland, dated November 21, 1966,	
and recorded in t	he Land Records of Prince George's County, Maryland in Liber 3558 at Folio	
835 (the "Propert	ty"); and	
WHEREAS	s, a sports arena was constructed on a portion of the Property and became known	
as the Capital Ce	ntre (subsequently known as the US Airways Arena); and	
WHEREAS	s, the establishment of the Revenue Authority of Prince George's County (the	
"Revenue Author	rity") was authorized by CB-84-1997 pursuant to Chapter 491 of the Laws of	
Maryland, 1996;	and	
WHEREAS	S, Section 5-103 of Article 28 of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that	
the title, control,	maintenance, or operation of property acquired within the Prince George's	
County portion o	f the metropolitan district may, by ordinance enacted by the County, be	
transferred to the	Revenue Authority; and	
WHEREAS	s, the County desires to transfer title, control and operation of the Property,	
including the Cap	pital Centre to the Revenue Authority; now therefore,

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,	
2	Maryland, that the transfer of the property known as the Capital Centre from the Maryland-
