WHEREAS, t	the County has been allocated \$1,802,242 in NSP3 funding; and
WHEREAS, i	in order to receive its NSP3 funding, the County is required by 75 Fed. Reg.
64322 (Oct. 19, 20)	10), to submit to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

("HUD") by March 1, 2011, a substantial amendment to its Annual Action Plan: FY 2011, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as the "Neighborhood Stabilization Program Round 3 ("NSP3"): Substantial Amendment to Annual Action Plan FY 2011" ("NSP3 Substantial Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the NSP3 Substantial Amendment designates the following census tracts in the Suitland community of Prince George's County as the NSP3 target area: 801802, 801902, 802001, 802002, 802105, 802405, and 802406 ("Suitland Neighborhood Stabilization Initiative"); and

WHEREAS, the NSP3 Substantial Amendment allows the County to use NSP3 funds in the amount of \$1,802,242 for eligible costs associated with homeownership activity including first mortgage principle reduction, down payment and closing cost assistance; acquisition, rehabilitation, and resale; general planning and administration; and associated project delivery costs; and

WHEREAS, the "FY 2011-2015 County Citizen Participation Plan" requires that the Annual Action Plan be amended when there is an "[a]addition of an eligible activity not originally funded or described in the Annual Action Plan;" and

WHEREAS, the NSP3 activity is an addition of an eligible activity not originally funded or described in the FY 2011 Annual Action Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County that the attached NSP3 Substantial Amendment, a copy of which shall be marked for identification by the Clerk of the County Council and maintained as a permanent record, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive or his designee is hereby authorized to submit the NSP3 Substantial Amendment to HUD, to act as necessary in connection with the submission, and to provide such additional information to HUD as may be required to facilitate approval and implementation of the NSP3 Substantial Amendment.
