LEGISLATION

1. **CB-06-2010 (Planning Board)** – An Ordinance concerning validity periods for Detailed Site Plans and Specific Design Plans for the purpose of temporarily suspending or tolling the validity period of all approved applications for Detailed Site Plans and Specific Design Plans with a valid status as of January 1, 2010.

Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Dean, Knotts, Bland, Dernoga and Olson)

2. **CB-07-2010 (Planning Board)**- A Subdivision bill concerning validity periods for Preliminary Plans of Subdivision for the purpose of temporarily suspending or tolling the validity period of all approved applications for Preliminary Plans of Subdivision with a valid status as of January 1, 2010.
