RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Citizens Advisory Boards

3 For the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study Parking Alternatives for Commercial
4 Vehicles in Residential Areas.

5 WHEREAS, there has been increasing concern over the illegal or improper overnight
6 parking of commercial vehicles in residential areas and its negative impact on surrounding
7 residential uses; and

8 WHEREAS, the Council desires to further examine the parking of commercial vehicles in
9 residential communities and suggest possible solutions, including the use of County land
10 adjacent to residential communities as commercial vehicle parking lots, and examining the
11 prospect of creating a "public-private partnership" for County-owned land to house the vehicles;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Prince George's County Charter provides that Council may
14 appoint, for designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County
15 who shall assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
17 County, Maryland, that a Task Force to Study Parking Alternatives for Commercial Vehicles in
18 Residential Areas is hereby established to review and evaluate the current practices relating to
19 overnight parking of commercial vehicles in residential communities and make
20 recommendations relating thereto.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force shall be composed of thirteen (13)
22 members:

- 1 1. Two (2) representatives of the County Council, who shall serve as the Chair and Vice
- 2 Chairperson;
- 3 2. A representative from the Office of the County Executive;
- 4 3. A representative from the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission;
- 5 4. A representative from the County Office of Central Services;
- 6 5. A representative from the Revenue Authority for Prince George’s County;
- 7 6. A representative from the Office of Law;
- 8 7. Three (3) members shall be representatives from the civic federation of the County,
- 9 with a member designated from the North, Central and Southern areas of the County;
- 10 and
- 11 8. Three (3) representatives from the County business community.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the first meeting of the Task Force shall be held on
13 December 10, 2008.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force shall present its report and
15 recommendation to the County Council on or before May 1, 2009.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator shall assign appropriate
17 technical and administrative support personnel to assist the Task Force in its work.
