RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Citizens Advisory Boards

For the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study Parking Alternatives for Commercial Vehicles in Residential Areas.

WHEREAS, there has been increasing concern over the illegal or improper overnight parking of commercial vehicles in residential areas and its negative impact on surrounding residential uses; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to further examine the parking of commercial vehicles in residential communities and suggest possible solutions, including the use of County land adjacent to residential communities as commercial vehicle parking lots, and examining the prospect of creating a "public-private partnership" for County-owned land to house the vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Prince George's County Charter provides that Council may appoint, for designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that a Task Force to Study Parking Alternatives for Commercial Vehicles in Residential Areas is hereby established to review and evaluate the current practices relating to overnight parking of commercial vehicles in residential communities and make recommendations relating thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force shall be composed of thirteen (13) members:

with a member designated from the	North, Central and Southern areas of the County

8. Three (3) representatives from the C	County business community.
