sign monitoring sy	stems may only be used at a location approved by the Prince George's County

Council and Sec. 26-120.02(c)(2)(C) provides that Council approval of the location of stop sign

1	monitoring systems used by municipalities shall be made by Council resolution upon receipt of a		
2	letter requesting such approval; and		
3	WHEREAS, the County Council is in receipt of the Town of Forest Heights Location		
4	Request Letter, Attachment 1 and supporting documents, including traffic violation data from		
5	high-risk intersections in school zones, demonstrating a critical need for automated enforcement;

7	WHEREAS, the Town of Forest Heights has documented numerous stop sign violations.
