WHEREAS	S, the U.S. Department of Education launched the Promise Neighborhoods
program in April	1 2010; and
WHEREAS	S, the Promise Neighborhoods program is the first federal initiative to put
education at the	center of comprehensive efforts to fight poverty in urban and rural areas; and
WHEREAS	S, the Promise Neighborhoods program brings all U.S. Department of Education
strategies togeth	er—high-quality early learning program, high-quality schools, and
comprehensive s	supports—to ensure that students are safe, healthy, and successful; and
WHEREAS	S, the Promise Neighborhoods program is based on the experience of programs
such as the Harle	em Children's Zone, which serves a large area in New York City and has
boosted student	outcomes dramatically; and
WHEREAS	S, under the Promise Neighborhoods program, nonprofits and institutions of
higher education	will be eligible for one-year grants supporting the design of comprehensive
community prog	rams; and
WHEREAS	S, the programs must have the specific goal of preparing students for success
and focus their efforts on schools in the neighborhood and build services for students in those	

WHEREAS, The Suitland Family and Life Development Corporation (SFLDC), a dynamic non-profit organization in Suitland, Maryland will serve as the fiscal agent for the Suitland

schools from birth through college to career; and

Promise Neighborhood Initiative; and WHEREAS, The Suitland Promise Neighborhood Initiative has formed a multi-sector coalition committed to creating and implementing a continuum of solutions at Drew Freeman Middle School to close the academic achievement gaps and eliminate levels of distress in Suitland, Maryland; and WHEREAS, The Suitland Promise Neighborhood Partnership has begun to engage in a planning process that provides reliable location and resources to students and their families to create an unobstructed line of access to services; and WHEREAS, The Suitland Promise Neighborhood Advisory Board will adapt the Communities That Care Model (CTC Model) to guide the efforts of the project; and NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Prince George's County hereby expresses support for the Suitland Promise Neighborhood Initiative. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council hereby expresses support for the Drew Freeman Middle School in Suitland, Maryland as the Promise Neighborhood school site. Adopted this 22nd day of June, 2010.
