PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 7/5/95

Committee Vote: No Recommendation, as amended, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Del Giudice, Gourdine and Maloney).

On June 29, 1995, the committee voted to hold this legislation for further discussion after the report by Shaver and Company, Inc.

The Legislative Officer stated that the legislation does not contain the findings required for it to be considered Emergency Legislation.

There would be a positive fiscal impact on the County. The amount related to the value of 50% of all sick leave currently retained by all General Schedule employees is approximately \$9,481,118.
