  - <u>FAVORABLE RECOMMENDATION WITH AMENDMENTS</u>

Council Member Olson moved amendment #1; seconded by Council Member Campos. Council Member Dernoga proffered a friendly amendment to allow for reduction in buffer to further revitalize or transit oriented development that would be difficult to achieve with a lesser buffer. The motion failed 2 – 7. Council Member Harrison moved to set the buffer at 60 with amendment language made by Council Member Dernoga; seconded by Council Member Olson. The motion carried 8-1. (Opposed: Council Member Dean). Council Member Olson moved amendment #2; seconded by Council Member Turner. The motion carried 8-0. (Absent: Council Member Knotts). Council Member Turner moved to approve the remaining amendments; seconded by Council Member Campos. The motion carried 9-0. Council Member Exum moved favorable recommendation with amendments; seconded by Council Member Olson. The motion carried 9-0.
