For the purpose of	of establishing a Charter Review Commission to review the provisions of the
Prince George's	County Charter, providing for the selection of the Commission and requiring
recommendation	s to the County Executive and the County Council within a certain period of
time.	
WHEREAS	S, the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland was adopted by the voters
of the County at	the General Election on November 3, 1970; and
WHEREAS	s, the provisions of the Charter took effect on December 3, 1970, and the first
County Executiv	e and additional members of the County Council were elected on January 26,
1971; and	
WHEREAS	S, while there have been numerous amendments of the Charter since its adoption
there has been no	o formal review of the document and its provisions since 1983, which review
was very limited	in scope; and
WHEREAS	S, it is appropriate to undertake a thoughtful and deliberative process to review
the provisions of	the Charter; and
WHEREAS	S, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council or the County Executive
may appoint, for	designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the
County who shal	l assist in the consideration of County policies and programs; and
WHEREAS	S, the County Executive has proposed to the Council the joint creation of a
citizens advisory	board to review the provisions of the Charter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

County, Maryland, that a temporary advisory board of citizens of the County is hereby created, which shall be known as the 2001 Charter Review Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2001 Charter Review Commission shall consist of seven (7) citizens, four (4) citizens appointed by the County Executive and three (3) citizens appointed by the County Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive shall nominate one of the members of the Commission to serve as Chairman, subject to the concurrence of the County Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2001 Charter Review Commission shall study the provisions of the Charter of Prince George's County, seeking extensive public comment, and shall make recommendations to the County Executive and County Council by January 30, 2002.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Administrative Officer shall provide appropriate staff and clerical support for the Charter Review Commission.
