CHARTER AMENDMENT

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Repeal of Section 307A, Charter of Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of proposing the repeal of Section 307A of the Charter of Prince George's
4 County, providing for term limitations for the County Executive and members of the County
5 Council.

6 BY proposing the repeal of:

7 Section 307A,

8 Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
10 Maryland, that the repeal of Section 307A, Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, is
11 hereby proposed:

12 **[Sec. 307A. Term Limitation.**

13 No person shall be eligible to serve more than two consecutive terms on the County
14 Council. No person shall be eligible to serve more than two consecutive terms as County
15 Executive. This Section shall apply to all persons who are currently serving on the County
16 Council or as County Executive on the effective date of this Section and to all persons elected
17 thereafter.]

18 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act shall be transmitted to
19 the County Executive for publication, and a copy shall also be transmitted to the Board of
20 Supervisors of Elections for submission of the proposed Charter Amendment to the voters of the
21 County at the 2000 General Election, pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter.

1 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the question of adoption of this proposed
2 Charter Amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the General Election
3 occurring on November 7, 2000, and shall be placed on the ballot in the following form:

4 PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

5 To repeal Section 307A of the Charter of Prince George's County,
6 which provides that the County Executive and members of the
7 County Council may not serve more than two consecutive terms.

 Adopted this ____ day of _____, 2000, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of
the members of the full County Council.
