1	F. Disability Insurance Benefits
2	The County Executive is authorized to prescribe by Executive Order a disability
3	insurance benefit program upon such terms and conditions as may be deemed by the County
4	Executive to be appropriate, subject to the following restrictions, provided that the benefits shall
5	be at least equivalent to any disability insurance program benefits offered to County employees:

7	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other provisions of the exempt salary
8	plan adopted by CR-179-1985 and amended previously by CR-4-1986, CR-77-1986, CR-14-
9	1988 and CR-78-2001, not amended by this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
10	SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all existing Executive Orders and
11	Resolutions approving and establishing additional individual benefits for current exempt service
12	employees are hereby confirmed and ratified and remain in full force and effect.
