A RESOLUTION concerning

Time Extension for the Parental Engagement and Education Program

For the purpose of extending the reporting date for recommendations from the Parental

Engagement and Education Program.

WHEREAS, Prince George's County Council on March 12, 2013 adopted CR-3-2013, establishing the Prince George's County Parents Academy Workgroup (hereinafter referred to as the "Workgroup"), a seventeen (17) member group, to explore best practices for parental engagement and support in public education and provide its recommendations to the Prince George's County Council by July 1, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Workgroup, through a series of meetings, decided to change their name to the Parental Engagement and Education Program (hereinafter referred to as the "Program"); and

WHEREAS, the County Council desires to provide additional time to the Program to examine and determine best practices for parental engagement and support in public education and to consider appropriate recommendations for implementation related thereto; and

WHEREAS, CR-3-2013 allows for a six month extension of the Program

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Program shall present its findings and recommendations to the County Council on or before January 1, 2014.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be sent by the Clerk of the Council to the County Executive.
