## BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

In September 2001 the Prince George=s County Gateway Arts District Planning Study was completed for the lower US 1 corridor including the municipalities of Mount Rainier, Brentwood, North Brentwood and Hyattsville. The study consists of an analysis of issues and opportunities, a vision for the area and recommended next steps, including preparation of a Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment (SMA).
