SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,

(a) After a	warrant of restitution is executed, the landlord shall dispose of the property of a		
tenant. In no event may any of the tenant's property be placed on a public right-of-way or on			
any public prope	rty. Any property removed from the leased premises pursuant to a properly		
issued warrant of	restitution shall be deemed abandoned.

- (b) If the tenant or the tenants' agent is present at the time the warrant of restitution is executed, the tenant shall be permitted to salvage and transport the tenant's property removed from the leased premises, after the warrant of restitution is executed, for a reasonable period of time, not to exceed four hours.
- (c) This section shall not apply to property owned by the County and other County agencies, authorities, and instrumentalities authorized pursuant to State or County law. [nor to Single Family Rental Facilities].

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
