REPORT: Favorable 5-0: Council Members Davis, Dernoga, Hawkins, Anderson-Walker and Streeter

CB-50-2019 is an act which would simply add the County Council as an entity authorized to designate Parking Areas in the County. The designation would be made by a Resolution of the County Council. It would not change the requirements or process for designating these areas but may result in a greater number of areas being considered for designation.

During the Committee meeting, comments were made by Ms. Dianne Harris, Community Relations Manager, Revenue Authority, supporting the bill. Comments were also made by Ms. Willea Graham and Ms. Diane Pierce, Hanson Oakes Homeowners Association, and Ms. Fern Siegler, Woodstream Village Homeowners Association. Each person spoke in favor of CB-50-2019.

The Office of Law reports CB -50-2019 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The Office of Audits and Investigations reports that the enactment of CB-50- 2019 should not have a direct negative fiscal impact on the County.

After discussion, the Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee voted CB-50-2019 out favorably, 5-0.
