RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Walkable Urban Streets Act of 2023

Roads and Sidewalks - Design and Construction Standards and Requirements

For the purpose of incorporating 2023 Urban Street Design Standards and Specifications as consistent with Plan Prince George's 2035 for Regional Transit Districts and Local Centers in Prince George's County, striving to balance the needs of all users that are business-friendly, walkable, bike-able and transit friendly; generally regarding design and construction standards and urban street designs.

WHEREAS, the 2023 Urban Street Design Standards are intended for use in designing of new and retrofit streets in the eight Regional Transit Districts and 26 Local Centers, as established by Plan Prince George's 2035 that have the necessary transit and transportation infrastructure to support future growth as mixed-use centers; and

WHEREAS, the County Council enacted CB-86-2015 calling for the development of new urban street standards. CR-85-2016 approved specifications and standards for Regional Transit Districts and Local Centers. The County adopted Urban Street Design Standards that set the standards and criteria for urban street standards for use in the Prince George's Regional Transit Districts and Local Centers that were consistent with the County Council's 2014 approval of its most current general plan for the County, Plan Prince George's 2035; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure that the Urban Street Design Standards adequately addressed the interests of multiple County departments and align with Complete Streets policies, the Department of Public Works and Transportation established a committee of representatives from

various departments to develop the new urban standards. Consultants with expertise in developing Complete Streets design standards provided assistance to the committee; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the work of the committee, the Prince George's County, Department of Public Works and Transportation Urban Street Design Standards, August 2017 (the "2017 Urban Street Design Standards") were promulgated; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Resolution to ratify and revise the 2017 Urban Street Design Standards; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 Urban Street Design Standards ("Exhibit A") sets standards and criteria for urban street standards for use in the Prince George's Regional Transit Districts and Local Centers, as attached and set forth and incorporated wholly herein; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A reflects the revisions to the 2017 Urban Street Design Standards document; and

WHEREAS, the County Council and the County Executive have determined, based upon the finding and determinations set forth herein, that it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the County that the County Council and the County Executive approve the 2023 Urban Street Design Standards as set forth in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, a forthcoming resolution shall be brought to the Council requesting amendments to the Prince George's County Code Subtitle 23, Roads, and Sidewalks, to incorporate the 2023 Urban Street Design Standards into the Specifications and Standards for Roadways and Bridges of the Department of Public Works and Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the 2023 Urban Street Design Standards set forth in Exhibit A be approved as comprehensive road design and construction standards for the Regional Transit Districts and Local Centers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the [Department of Public Works and Transportation] Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission shall present an annual report to the County Council on the progress of implementation of Complete Streets policies and the 2023 Urban Street Design Standards and stated goals. The annual report shall state the extent to which these goals, policies, and standards were or were not achieved for each project and explain why. The annual report shall be published on the Department of Public Works and Transportation's website and be made available in print form, upon request. The annual report shall include detailed

descriptions of actions and summary project drawings, plans, budget information, progress timeline for past and future actions for each road related project. In addition to the annual report and summary information about each project, detailed project documents shall be provided on a publicly accessible website of the Department of Public Works and Transportation with posted links for each project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Public Works and Transportation shall develop a 10-year plan by January 2025 to bring the streets in the County's Regional Transit Districts and Local Centers into compliance with the 2023 Urban Street Design Standards. The Department of Public Works and Transportation shall report annually on progress to the County Council on the comprehensive efforts to bring all these streets into compliance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission and the Department of Public Works and Transportation shall develop a ten-year implementation plan for Urban Street retrofits, which shall contain context-appropriate street recommendations, prioritization, and timing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission and the Department of Public Works and Transportation shall reestablish the Urban Streets Design Workgroup.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the implementation date for the provisions of this Resolution shall be June 1, 2024.
