CB-14-2011 - AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING INSTITUTIONAL LAND

<u>USES</u> for the purpose of allowing Institutional buildings or structures located in residential zones to be one hundred twenty (120) feet in height, provided that, for each one (1) foot increase in height, every yard is increased by one (1) foot. <u>PRESENTED</u>

Council Bill 14 was presented by Council Member Harrison and referred to the Planning, Zoning and Economic Development Committee (PZED).

for the purpose of making clarifying amendments to the County law regarding the
exercise of certain powers of the District Council by municipal corporations. PUBLIC

CR-24-2011 (DR-2) - A RESOLUTION CONCERNING SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATIONS OF FEDERAL, STATE AND OTHER FUNDS for the purpose of appropriating funding from grants in the amount of \$7,855,204 to the Police Department, Department of Housing and Community Development, Department of Social Services, Fire/EMS Department, Office of Homeland Security, the Health Department, Department of Family Services and the Soil Conservation District. *DR-2 SUBSTITUTED*; *ADOPTED*

Council Member Franklin moved to substitute DR-2 in lieu of DR-1; seconded by Council Member Patterson. The motion carried by voice vote. (Absent: Council Member Campos). Council Member Franklin moved adoption of Council Resolution 24 (DR-2); seconded by Council Member Olson. The motion carried 8-0 (Absent: Council Member Campos).
