7	accordance with Subtitle 28 of this Code. The appellant shall notify the Board of the appeal
8	within [thirty (30)] five (5) business days after the refusal of the permit, issuance of the notice, o
9	other decision. For purposes of this subsection, "issuance of a zoning violation" means the
10	earlier of the date of posting, the date of personal service, or if mailed, the date that the notice
11	was postmarked.
