4	Notwithstanding any other provision of this Subtitle, a grading permit to support the										
5	development of property in the LCD Zone may be issued by the Department of Permitting,										
6	Inspections, and Enforcement so long as it is in conformance with an approved CDP, or an										
7	approved Type 1 Tree Conservation Plan. The grading permit shall be limited to activities relate										
8	to the installation of utilities, streets, stormwater management facilities, and lot grading based or										
9	the approved limits of disturbance as shown on the approved CDP or the approved Type 1 Tree										
10	Conservation Plan. An SDP and a Final Plat are not required for issuance of a grading permit if										
11	the permit is limited to activities related to the installation of utilities, streets, stormwater										
12	management facilities, and lot grading based on the approved limits of disturbance as shown on										
13	the approved CDP or the approved Type 1 Tree Conservation Plan.										
14	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45)
