RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Revenue Authority of Prince George's County Fiscal Year

3 2003-2004 Operating Budget and Capital Improvement Program

4 For the purpose of approving the Capital Improvement Program of the Revenue Authority of
5 Prince George's County for Fiscal Years 2004-2009, prepared pursuant to the authority contained
6 in Subtitle 21A of the Prince George's County Code and providing comments on the proposed
7 Operating Budget of the Authority for Fiscal Year 2003-2004.

8 WHEREAS, Section 21A-119 of the Prince George's County Code provides that the
9 Revenue Authority of Prince George's County may propose one or more projects for inclusion in
10 the Authority's Capital Improvement Program and that the County Executive shall transmit to the
11 County Council for its approval by resolution or ordinance any such project approved by the
12 County Executive; and

13 WHEREAS, the Capital Improvement Program for the Revenue Authority includes two
14 future parking projects totaling approximately 6000 parking spaces, the College Park / Riverdale
15 TDOZ facilities (TG660533) and the New Carrollton Parking District (TG66513) projects; for
16 which copies of the project descriptions are attached hereto as Attachment 1; and

17 WHEREAS, the Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2004 equals zero dollars; and

18 WHEREAS, Section 21A-118 of the Prince George's County Code provides that if the
19 proposed operating budget of the Authority includes any item to be funded from payments to be
20 received from the County that the anticipated receipts shall be identified for each item and a copy
21 of the proposed budget shall be transmitted by the Authority to the County Executive and the
22 County Council for their review and comment; and

1 WHEREAS, the Authority has forwarded its proposed operating budget to the County
2 Executive and the County Council for review and comment as shown in Attachment 2.

3 SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince
4 George's County, Maryland, that subject to and in accordance with the authority of the Charter of
5 Prince George's County and pursuant to Subtitle 21A of the Prince George's County Code, the
6 Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2004-2009 of the Revenue Authority of Prince
7 George's County, as submitted by the County Executive to the County Council, a copy of which
8 is attached hereto as Attachment 1 and incorporated herein by reference as though it was set forth
9 fully herein, is hereby authorized, approved, and adopted.

10 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council has reviewed the
11 proposed Operating Budget, Fiscal Year 2003-2004, of the Revenue Authority of Prince
12 George's County and concurs with the proposed Operating Budget of the Revenue Authority.
