A RESOLUTION concerning

Budget Priorities - Fiscal Year 1998

For the purpose of expressing support for the County Executive's proposed FY 1998 budget to fund enhanced services in the areas of education, public safety, public health and economic development if additional sources of revenue are made available.

WHEREAS, the County Executive has developed a proposed budget for Fiscal Year 1998 in anticipation of future potential revenues resulting from a shift in existing sources of revenue, the repeal of the existing tax rate limitation (commonly referred to as TRIM), and the authorization of additional sources of revenue by the Maryland General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget directs the overwhelming majority of additional potential revenues to fund the critical areas of education, public safety, public health and economic development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that if additional sources of revenue are made available in the County Executive's proposed Fiscal Year 1998 budget, the Council hereby agrees to support the fundamental framework of the County Executive's proposed budget as a blueprint for providing necessary funding to enhance quality services in the critical areas of education, public safety, public health and economic development.
