WHEREAS, the Cha	arter of Prince George's County, Maryland provides for the adoption of
the County budget, which	includes the capital budget and capital program; and
WHEREAS, pursuar	nt to CB-33-2000, the County budget, known as the Annual Budget and
Appropriation Ordinance	of Prince George's County for Fiscal Year 2000-2001, which includes
the Fiscal Year 2001-2006	6 Capital Improvement Program - Fiscal Year 2001 Capital Budget was
adopted; and	
WHEREAS, the App	proved Fiscal Year 2001-2006 Capital Improvement Program sets forth
the plan of the County to	receive and expend funds for capital projects during the fiscal year
covered by the capital bud	lget and the next succeeding five fiscal years thereafter and also the
means of financing said p	rojects; and
WHEREAS, pursuar	nt to Section 818 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland,
the County Council may authorize, by legislative act, upon request of the County Executive,	
interproject transfers of ap	propriations between capital projects in the Approved Capital Budget;

WHEREAS, the County Executive deems it desirable to provide additional appropriations

1 for the Cheverly Renovation capital project (II700023) as currently existing appropriations are 2 inadequate for project completion; and 3 WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends that appropriations can be transferred from 4 the Contingency Fund, as an excess of appropriations over estimated costs in the budget year 5 exists; and WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the amendment of the Approved Fiscal 6 7 Year 2001-2006 Capital Improvement Program with regard to the Cheverly Renovation capital 8 project to reflect a change in expenditures beyond the budget year; now, therefore 9 SECTION 1.
