### BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 An Interproject Transfer of Appropriations in the Approved Fiscal Year 2001 Capital Budget

3 For the purpose of transferring appropriations between capital projects in the amount of

4 \$892,000 from the Contingency Fund to the Cheverly Renovation capital project, and amending

5 the Approved Fiscal Year 2001-2006 Capital Improvement Program with regard to expenditures

6 and financing beyond the budget year.

7 WHEREAS, the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland provides for the adoption of  
8 the County budget, which includes the capital budget and capital program; and

9 WHEREAS, pursuant to CB-33-2000, the County budget, known as the Annual Budget and  
10 Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George's County for Fiscal Year 2000-2001, which includes  
11 the Fiscal Year 2001-2006 Capital Improvement Program - Fiscal Year 2001 Capital Budget was  
12 adopted; and

13 WHEREAS, the Approved Fiscal Year 2001-2006 Capital Improvement Program sets forth  
14 the plan of the County to receive and expend funds for capital projects during the fiscal year  
15 covered by the capital budget and the next succeeding five fiscal years thereafter and also the  
16 means of financing said projects; and

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 818 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland,  
18 the County Council may authorize, by legislative act, upon request of the County Executive,  
19 interproject transfers of appropriations between capital projects in the Approved Capital Budget;  
20 and

21 WHEREAS, the County Executive deems it desirable to provide additional appropriations

for the Cheverly Renovation capital project (II700023) as currently existing appropriations are inadequate for project completion; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends that appropriations can be transferred from the Contingency Fund, as an excess of appropriations over estimated costs in the budget year exists; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the amendment of the Approved Fiscal Year 2001-2006 Capital Improvement Program with regard to the Cheverly Renovation capital project to reflect a change in expenditures beyond the budget year; now, therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Fiscal Year 2001 Approved Capital Budget is hereby amended, as shown on Schedule A and Schedule B, attached hereto and made a part hereof, to provide that appropriations are transferred as follows:
