**RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION concerning

The Listing of Local Questions on the 2000 Ballot

For the purpose of designating the order and certifying the form in which local questions shall be placed on the 2000 ballot.

WHEREAS, Article 33, Sections 7-103 and 7-104 of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that the County Council shall designate the order and certify the form in which local questions shall appear on the ballot.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the order and form in which local questions shall appear on the ballot for the November, 2000 general election shall be as follows:

**QUESTION A**

**PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT**

To change part of Section 307A of the Charter of Prince George's County, to allow the County Executive to serve more than two consecutive terms.

**QUESTION B**

**PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT**

To change part of Section 307A of the Charter of Prince George's County, to allow members of the County Council to serve more than two consecutive terms.

**QUESTION C****PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITIES BONDS**

An Act enabling the County to borrow money and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding \$15,387,000 to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation or repair of Public Safety Facilities (including Fire Department Facilities), as defined therein.

**QUESTION D****COMMUNITY COLLEGE FACILITIES BONDS**

An Act enabling the County to borrow money and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding \$18,500,000 to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation or repair of Community College Facilities, as defined therein.

**QUESTION E****LIBRARY FACILITIES BONDS**

An Act enabling the County to borrow money and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding \$2,968,000 to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation or repair of Library Facilities, as defined therein.

**QUESTION F****PUBLIC WORKS AND TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES BONDS**

An Act enabling the County to borrow money and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding \$117,516,000 to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation or repair of Public Works and Transportation Facilities (including road and bridges, parking lots, and maintenance facilities), as defined therein.

**QUESTION G**

**COUNTY BUILDINGS BONDS**

An Act enabling the County to borrow money and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding \$17,726,000 to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation or repair of County Buildings, as defined therein.

**QUESTION H**

**REFUSE FEES**

An Act to reduce the residential base benefit fee rate by \$20.00 and to impose a new commercial rate for garbage and trash collection and disposal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Prince George's County Board of Elections by the Clerk of the Council.
