BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The County Labor Code was first enacted into law in 1973. The proposed resolution would establish a work group comprised of representatives of the Council and Executive, the Personnel Officer, the County Attorney, representatives of AFSCME, FOP, IAFF and support staff to review the Labor Code and recommend appropriate amendments to the Labor Code and labor relations practices to the Council and the Executive by September 26, 1995.
