BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Cannabis Reinvestment and Restoration Board

3 For the purpose of increasing the size of the Cannabis Reinvestment and Restoration Board;
 4 providing appointing authority to at-large Council members; and setting the initial term of
 5 members appointed by an at-large Council member.

6 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

7 SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

8 Sections 2-166 and 2-167,

9 The Prince George's County Code

10 (2023 Edition; 2024 Supplement).

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 12 Maryland, that Sections 2-166 and 2-167 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same
 13 are hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

14 SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

15 DIVISION 9. CANNABIS REINVESTMENT AND RESTORATION BOARD.

16 Sec. 2-166. Membership Appointments and Requirements.

17 (a) **Member Appointments.** The Board shall be comprised of [thirteen (13)] fifteen (15)
 18 members appointed by the County Council and County Executive pursuant to Section 402 of the
 19 County Charter:

20 (1) The County Council shall appoint [nine (9)] eleven (11) members representing
 21 each of the nine (9) councilmanic districts and two (2) at-large positions.

Sec. 2-167. Terms.

- (a) Generally.
- (1) The initial terms of voting members shall be staggered so as follows:
- (i) Three (3) members appointed by the Council shall serve initial terms of two (2) years;
- (ii) Three (3) members appointed by the Council shall serve initial terms of three (3) years;
- (iii) [Three (3)] Five (5) members appointed by the Council shall serve initial terms of four (4) years; and
- (iv) Four (4) members appointed by the County Executive shall serve initial terms of four (4) years.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
